## **Kingdom Vision**

Kingdom vision is about seeing things in the eyes of God. Vision deals with God's perspectives on issues. Our lives daily should be a composition of kingdom vision-seeing things in the eyes of God or living our lives daily as God has ordained it.

### **\*The kingdom is a treasure- Matt 13:44-46**

**Mat 13:44** "The kingdom of heaven is like *treasure hidden in a field*. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and *sold all he had* and bought that field.

Mat 13:45 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for **fine pearls**.

Mat 13:46 When he *found one of great value*, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it.

### **\*God's kingdom is worth selling all to obtain**

**Mat 13:31** He told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field.

**Mat 13:32** Though it is the smallest of all seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds come and perch in its branches."

**Mat 13:33** He told them still another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into about sixty pounds of flour until *it worked all through the dough*."

When you allow His kingdom into your life, very soon His kingdom takes over. This is the drive for all the spiritual guidance this year. Seek first the kingdom and everything that pertains to its righteousness and then all others will be added to you-**Matt 6:33**

## Zoe Family Chapel-Vision 2025

### Divine Alignment – 1Co 9:24

Without vision (purpose), there is no discipline and there is no destination. Vision of what God has for you can fuel you to overcome afflictions, barriers, discouragements to attain the desired glory-2 Cor 4:16-18

Threefold process- visualize, vocalize. and actualize it -See the impossible, believe the impossible, confess the impossible and run to make it a reality.

Write the vision down and make it plain- Hab 2:2,3

*Creating an Apostolic Community*- this is simply a community in which every member has given themselves to be trained, equipped and therefore, can be sent on a mission for God.

### This is intentional capacity building- Matt 7:24; Luk 14:28

\*Build the house on the Rock (Jesus) -Hearing the words and doing them.

Spiritual growth - prayer, study, soul winning, fellowship, and discipleship.

When. You give yourself wholly to these core things. The evidence is prosperity of spirit, soul, and body. You move from healing to health, peace of mind and enter a state of rest.

## **Organizational**

Allow the various departmental leadership to take care of their various assignments.

## What is in fasting?

Fasting means abstinence. Fasting is a decision to let our external actions portray our actual feeling/state of the soul/heart. A true fast will therefore align our external choices with the state of the heart- **Joel 2:12-17**.

In fasting, we deny the cravings of the natural man so that we can feed the desires of the inner man-**Eph 3:16**. Starve your flesh and feed your spirit; starve your doubts and feed your faith- **Rom 8:5-13; Gal 5:16**. A liberated inward man will lead to a liberated outward man. So, get ready for the joy of the Lord to surge in you as you focus your attention on Him.

When you take time off the beginning of the year to embark on a fast, it is like giving a first fruit to God. You are *surrendering* your first and your best without delay to the Lord and He has the responsibility of aligning the rest for you. **Rom 11:16; Matt 6:33**. You are seeking what pertains to kingdom living first and expect the rest to follow. God will not disappoint you. Some scriptural highlights on fasting

### The Essence of Fasting

\*Fasting is a time for the old to die for a new you to emerge- **Jhn 12:23-25**

\*Fasting is a time for changing the course of our life, from one realm of glory to a greater glory. It could be a time to mourn over past choices. – **Joel 2:12**

\*Fasting that does not affect your heart condition, leading to the emerging of new you is pure starvation- **Joel 2:13; Isa 58:3-7; Mat 15:8**

\*Fasting helps us to subdue/starve the needs of the flesh and feed our spirit man. There is a constant battle between the desires of our flesh and the Spirit- **Gal 5:16, 17,19; Rom 8:5; Ga 6:8**

\*Fasting bends (transforms) us to conform to the will of God for our lives- **Rom 12:1,2**

\*Fasting creates the opportunity to get rid of the yeast. **Ex 12:8**- new life; **1 Cor 5:1-8; Matt 13:33**

\*Drop off the old weight of sin, doubt, and error- **Heb 12:1**-drop them

\*Let go of people who do not belong to your destiny- **1 Jo 2:18,19; Luke 14:26; Ruth 1:14; Isa 6:1**-Eliminate Uzziah or Orpah

\*Recognize your weakness/inadequacies and ask for the help of God in the issue-**2 Chro 20:1-4; Is 40:29; 2 Cor 12:9; Psa 121**

\*Repentance -which attracts God's favor again-**2 Chr 7:14; Dan 9; Neh 1:4**

\*An opportunity to hear God's instructions-**Acts 13:2,3; Luke 4:1**

\*Activating Prophecies or Prophetic words - **Dan 9:1; 1 Tim 1:18, Mark 11:23, 1Ki 18:11**

### **Kings 18:41-46**

\*A holy event dedicated to honor God, which produces tremendous results. The focus for your fast should be I am preparing a special body to honor God. Fasting does not save us or make us holy-**1 Cor 6:19, 20; Joel 2:15; Mark 3:14; 1 Pet 1:15**

\*Fasting helps us to give attention to the God- to study the word, meditate the word, pray the word, and obey the word -**Mar 4:14-20; Eze 11:19**

-Study His Word-**2 Tim 3:16,17; 2 Tim 2:15; Ezra 7:10; Matt 7:24; Jos 1:8**

-Meditate (ponder, attend, practice)-**1 Tim 4:15-give self wholly; Mark 1:35**

\*Separation from self and unto the Lord-**Isa 58:3-9; Mark 9:29**

-Breaking bondages of the past-**Bond-chain fetters wickedness-fraud, abuse, injustice-**

**-the ultimate benefit of fasting is to experience the love of God/ freedom-1 Jo 3:8-11**

*\*The release of the game plan/favor for your call-Esther 4:14-17*

*-rebuilding and restoration-Neh 1:2-11; Isaiah 58:12*

*\*Fasting releases the power of Holy Spirit-Luke 4:1, 14*

*\*Fasting releases angelic help-Acts 27:21-25; Dan 9:3, 20; Dan 10*

### ***How do we fast?***

*\*Set a plan for your fast-how many days, how long-trust God to help you-Dan 9:3; Dan 10:2; Isa 40:29, -strength is given for assignment- reward is given for completion.*

*-Esther fasted for three days no food– Esther 4:15-17*

*-Daniel fasted 21 days without eating pleasant bread – Dan 10:2*

*\*Set a spiritual expectation for the fast-Ezra 8:21; Acts 13:2; 3; Eph 3:20-(intimate walk with God, salvation and healing for family, deliverance from bondage, health issues, etc)*

*\*Keep a prayer journal around-Isa 50:4; Hab 2:2*

*-this is to help you document your interactions with God. You write what He tells you, and you also write down the prayers He inspires you to pray.*

*\*Get hold of your Bible and a book on those issues-1 Cor 11:1; 2Ti 3:16*

*-when you study the bible during fasting, you allow the Holy Spirit to take out what needs to be taken out and to build you up.*

*-allow the Holy Spirit to lead, teach, guide, reveal, fill and empower you throughout the fasting period. Avoid useless arguments, etc and be sensitive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit (like pray for someone, call, encourage etc)*

*\*Set/fix your desires on things above (from the Word-which is eternal)- Col 3:1*

*-Put to death works of the flesh*

*-Take out any root of bitterness, immorality, impurity, lust (eyes, flesh, pride), greed, rage, anger; slander, lies, filthy language*

*-allow God to clothe you with humility, compassion, patience, forgiving heart*

*\*As you wait on the Lord in prayer and in fasting let your desire be set on receiving the fullness of His presence/power for the assignment. Genuinely desire to let go of the past hurts, failures, disappointments. He cannot do it for you; you must put them off consciously. These things are like baggage that we are carrying. They slow us down and hinder us from reaching our goal (Heb 12). Like Jesus let us throw anything that is a weight or sin off and let us faithfully run the race that He has set before us for there is a reward for only those who overcome.*



## 21-Day fast- Blow the Trumpet in Zion -Joel 2

### Prayer Guide 2025- Overflow

#### Day 1-3-Deal with things that hinder us-Heb 12:1

##### Day 1- Dealing with Personal Besetting sins-Psalm 51; 1 John 1:6-10; Daniel 9:3-20

Access the past year(s)-ask the Holy Spirit to show you-**Psalm 19:12-14**-talks about secret and deliberate sins. There are things that trap us easily, you want to deal with them- **Psalm 139:23,24**. Allow the Spirit to point out areas that you fall short consistently and deal with it in prayer. God has solved the sin problem by sending His Son Jesus to die for us-**2 Cor 5:17-20**. He paid the penalty of our sins and broke the power of sin over our lives-**Rom 6:1-6**  
**Acknowledge** God that He keeps covenant, and He is full of mercy (makes room for our faults in our attempt to honor Him)-**Psalm 103:11-12; Lam 3:22**

Acknowledge that there have been some desolate areas in your relationships (spouse, children, relatives etc) and there has been some scattering abroad and tell the Lord it is time your to bring us together.

**Remind Him of His redemptive** power in the Blood of Jesus, apply that upon your family; and this is the time for you to make demands on His strong Hand to bring deliverance to you and your family. This is a reconstruction process. We start in the spirit, and we will see the results in the physical.

- Acknowledge, confess, and renounce any known sins in your life.
- Pray for a broken, contrite heart and the humility to confess sin as you fast and pray.
- Ask for mercies in the blood and plead the blood to purge every sin in your life, to deal with the root of sin in your life.
- Let go of any behavior/tendencies that drags you down spiritually and set yourself free from chains and chords that tie you to the past
- Ask for the restorative power of God to strengthen you. Create in me a new heart that pants after You oh Lord.
- Thank God for His mercy and kindness that has preserved you and your family from harm.
- Plead the blood of Jesus as a covering of protection over your household, church, and nation.
- Ask the Lord to release angelic protection around your children and preserve their going out and coming in.

##### Prayer Points

- I thank You Father for ushering us into a new year. I thank You for Your grace and mercies that has kept us. We thank You for this season of consecration – **Psa 103**.
- I access the mercies in the blood for cleansing of sins known and unknown in the past year- **Heb 9:14; 1 Jo 1:7-10**.
- Father, deliver me from deliberate sins that leads to a defiled/seared conscience -**1 Ti 1:19; Psa 68; 1Ti 4:1,2**
- I cut myself free from the bondage of sin – **Rom 6:12-14**
- I destroy any seed of the enemy or iniquity in my life -**1 John 3:8**
- Let Your mercy triumph over every demand of justice for my wrong doings- **Jas 2:13**.

- Anywhere my careless life has opened the door for a curse to remain, I repent quickly, and I ask that the mercy of God will overturn every judgment of the wicked against me.
- Where my actions opened doors for the enemy to gain access to my soul, I ask for mercy.
- Let the blood purge me and bring back my soul from captivity.

## **Day 2-Deal with anger and bitterness-Eph 4:31; Heb 12:15**

Hurt and disappointments are part of life. They should be expected in every human interaction because human beings are prone to failure in the natural and bible says you are cursed if you rely on any man-**Matthew 18:7; Jer 17:5,6**

When offended, you have a choice to forgive, deal with the hurt and be restored; or you can hold unto the hurt, which generates anger and bitterness. When this continues, it opens doors for the enemy to enslave us. God's word tells to forgive and not hold unto anger. Therefore, if someone has offended or disappointed you forgive them just as you have been forgiven -**Mark 11:25,26; Matt 18:21-35.**

Anger and bitterness dry you up and hinders you from being creative. They are weights we carry that hinder as from going forward. It is time to drop them-**Heb 12:1; Phil 3:12**

- Father, forgive me for holding the sins of others against them – **Mark 11:25**
- In the name of Jesus, I uproot, breakdown, and dissolve any root of anger or bitterness (be it against men or God)
- I break the hold of bitterness, rejection etc from your life in Jesus' name.
- I destroy and break myself free yourself from any mindset that festers these tendencies -**2 Cor 10:3-6**
- I plead the blood to purge me of any consequences of holding onto these negative emotions
- Father, baptize me with the spirit of love and joy – **Rom 5:4**

### **Supplication and Intercession**

- I consecrate my children to You and ask that You deliver them from every evil and bring them into the company of people who will inspire them to live righteously.
- Father, order my steps in the right track – **Psalm 23**
- Father, expose and deliver me from the snares of the enemy – **Psa 124**
- I receive divine insight from the Lord to escape every trap fashioned to abort my destiny and rob me of my glory – **Psa 124**
- Let the wicked fall in the trap that they have prepared for me- **Pro 26:27**
- Father, I pray for ministers/missionaries of the gospel that You will grant them utterance and deliver them from the evil one- **2Th 3:1,2**
- I destroy any satanic assignment designed against my family and I in Jesus name – **Job 12:5; Isa 54:17**
- I cover every child in my household with the blood of Jesus and command every satanic bondage and activity over their lives to be destroyed- **Rev 12:11**

### **Day 3-Deal with procrastination and slothfulness -Jos 23:6**

To procrastinate means to *delay action* or to postpone action or defer to do something. People procrastinate because they are lazy, tired, or not sure of the benefits of their action. Delayed obedience is disobedience. Delayed seed will lead to delayed harvest. Delayed harvest can lead to rotten harvests. Timing is very important with God. God loves a cheerful (prompt) giver- 2 Cor 9:6. Procrastination is akin to being double-minded. God hates the double minded. **Jas 1:8**. Lot's wife looked back, and she was stuck in the past-**Gen 19:16**-deliver me from the snares of the past.

It is time to purify yourself from this habit. As you journey in this New Year, you want to strike when the iron is hot. Be deliberate and immediate. **Jas 4:8**

Don't delay-**Ex 22:29**

#### **Confessions, Supplication and Intercession**

- Father, I ask for forgiveness for lifestyle of procrastination and laziness
- I break and destroy the covenants and curses of procrastination over my life in Jesus' name.
- By the blood of Jesus, I cancel any delay/laziness programmed against my life- **Pro 12:24**
- I pray for a fresh baptism of the spirit of diligence- **Pro 12:24; Rom 12:11**
- I pray for the spirit that takes prompt actions- **Matt 25:16**
- I cancel the voice of any wicked altar that draws me back from doing what you I am instructed to do-**Luke 9:59-62, Heb 3:7-19**
- My heart will respond promptly to the conviction of the Holy Spirit
- Let me life be defined by consistency of action-**2 Cor 6:2**
- Father, bless the work of my hands and give me a thousand times increase- **Deu 1:11; Gen 26:12**
- Father, visit every Christian business, breathe on them and make them fruitful – **Eze 37**
- Father, surround my household with Your favor like a shield – **Psalm 5:12**
- Father, grant me spiritual wisdom to access all that You have freely given me – **Eph 1:17; 1 Cor 2:9-12**
- Father, may my sacrifices ascend to you and be acceptable in Your sight – **Acts 10:1-5**
- I activate the blood of Jesus to erase the blindfold and cause the eyes of unbelievers to be opened to receive the gospel – **2 Cor 4:4**
- Father, empower more people to preach the gospel – **Rom 10:10-14; 2 Cor 3:5**

#### **Day 4-6-The New Creation-Matthew 6:9**

Jesus taught His disciples how to pray in **Matt 6:9**. The first words He taught them was to recognize that prayer is a communication between a Father and a child. The basis of prayer is thus relationship. Jesus taught the disciples to pray by acknowledging God as their Father. When the believer walks in that consciousness, he/she operates in a boldness that guarantees answers to prayers-**1 John 5:14-15**

#### **Day 4-I am a new Creation-2 Cor 5:17-20**

##### **Confessions for the day**

- I am a brand-new person-**2 Cor 5:17; 1 Peter 1:23**. I have been redeemed by the precious blood of Jesus. My past has been erased. There is no condemnation against me. The blood that Jesus shed was enough to cover my past, present and future sins.
- I was crucified and resurrected with Christ and so my new life, is a life of faith- **Gal 2:20**
- My resurrected life is no longer a slave to sin and errors -**Rom 6:1-12**.
- I remove my name and that of my family from ancestral altars that I was covenanted with
- I willingly surrender my body to serve God.
- My lifestyle reflects what God has done for me. I talk like Jesus and do everything like Him because He has made me just like Him.
- I have received unique grace to live the godly lifestyle- **Titus 2:11**
- I have eternal life for I have received the life of Christ- **John 3:16; 1John 5:11-13**

##### **Supplication and Intercession**

- I intercede for missionaries and their families that the Lord will empower them and grant them boldness to preach the gospel- **2Th 3:1,2**
- Father, grant me wisdom and insight to be a shining light for You in my workplace – **Matt 5:13-16**
- Father, grant me the boldness to preach the good news to all I encounter, and back the message with signs and wonders following – **Acts 4:29-31**
- Father, grant me wisdom to rise above every limitation and let me prosper in my career, academic or business.
- Father, bless the works of my hands and grant me speed- **Deu 28:1-12**

#### **Day 5- I am a new creation in Christ**

##### **Confessions for the day**

God has made me a royal priest-**1 Pet 2:9**-I am a priest and a king at the same time. As a priest, I have the privilege to enter boldly into the throne of grace and receive mercy and grace when I need it-**Heb 4:14-16**. I have been given the unique responsibility to offer up intercessions for those who are connected to me. I therefore plead for the lives of my family members in the name of Jesus.

- As a king I have authority to legislate, to issue decrees and it shall be established- **Job 22:28**.
- I have authority to step over serpents and scorpions and over any power of the enemy- **Luke 10:19**

- I take authority over any foul spirit, witchcraft, sorcery, spiritual wickedness that operates in my circle in Jesus' name-**2Thess 2:11,12; Col 1:10; Eph 4:1; 24; Matt 3:7**
- I have the keys of the kingdom, and what I allow will be allowed and what I disallow will be disallowed. I disallow **any force** of the enemy in the name of Jesus-**Matt 16:18-20**
- In Christ, I am seated far above any principality of powers; therefore, I trample on any device of the enemy formed against me life- **Eph 2:6; Eph 1:19**
- I am no longer a slave to fear, but I walk in boldness-**Eph 2:6; Eph 1:19**
- I am more than a conqueror in every engagement. I triumph and trample on all the works of the devil -**Rom 8:31; Luke 10:19**
- I deploy the angels of God to arrest any strong man who has tied my destiny

### Supplication and Intercession

- I root out and destroy any mindset or thought pattern that hinders me from experiencing the fullness of God in my life – **2 Cor 10:3-5**
- Father, exalt my head above my enemies – **Psalm 3:2,3**
- Father, to crown this year with His goodness and cause my path to drip with Your abundant provisions – **Psa 65:11**
- Father, guide the leaders of this church and let them fulfill their calling –
- Father, protect our president and other leaders. Guide their hearts to make godly decisions – **1 Ti 2:1-5**
- Father, raise a shield of protection over our nation - **Zech 2**

### Day 6- New Creation - Confessions for the day

- In Christ I have received **ALL things** that I need to live a godly and physical life-**2 Pet 1:2-10.**
- I have been made a participant of God's nature through His mighty promises that says that I am above not beneath.
- I have been sealed with the Holy Spirit- **Eph1:13; Eph 4:30**-I live daily in the consciousness that God is with me and in me.
- Through the power of the Holy Spirit, I have come into awareness of everything that God has made available for me-**1 Cor 2:9-16**
- I have the mind of Christ, so I am no longer prone to making mistakes.
- I am no longer subject to errors that will set me back in all areas of my life.
- I have **the creative ability of God**. I am receiving insight into my calling, career, and family to do what is right at the right time.
- I have been placed in an exalted position and so have superior knowledge-**Eph 2:4-6; Eph 1:20**
- God is working in me and through me; I cannot make mistake-**Philip 2:13**
- I have entered a partnership with God-**Philip 2:13**
- I have passed from death to life, death has no power over me- **Col 1:13**

### Supplication and Intercession

- Father, prosper me abundantly and make me a channel of blessing to many-**Gen 12**
- Father, I come against every attitude that will hinder my spiritual growth in you

- Father, I pray that You bless members my church family to grow strong in faith
- I pray for all Children, Youth, and Young Adults in the church that they be empowered to stay pure in a perverse world - **Phil 2:15**

### **Day 7-Thanksgiving Day**

Thank God for a first week of prayer. A prayer of thanksgiving is an expression of our faith in the ability of God to do what we have entrusted in His hands. Praise is a weapon that silences the enemy and puts him in chains-**Psalm 149:6-9**. Thanksgiving removes anxiety and replaces it with peace of God-**Phil 4:6,7**

- Ask God for renewed strength to pursue Him more this week
- Pray for strength and directions from the Holy Spirit as you begin a fresh week of fasting and prayer
- Let the benefit of fast which includes revelation by my portion in Jesus' name-**Isai 58:6-12**
- I thank You Father, for watering every dry area in my life
- I thank You Father for total turn around in my condition just like You did for Esther
- I thank You for Your insight and directions You gave me.

### **Supplications and Intercession**

- Father, I ask for continual guidance in the coming week.
- I ask Blessed Holy Spirit that You guide me more and more into my life's purpose and help me lead a purposeful life- **Prov 4:18; John 16:8**
- Father, let my local assembly and churches across this city be filled with the knowledge of Your glory.
- In the name of Jesus, I reject every ungodly counsel that seeks to direct me outside the will of God.
- Blessed Holy Spirit, in the coming weeks, illuminate and grant me understanding of the scriptures as I pray and study Your Word.
- I pray against any attack on your body, spirit, and soul in Jesus' name -**1Th 5:23**
- Father, let the blood of Jesus protect and exempt my family from satanic attacks – **Pas 91**

## Week 2-Day 8-10-Praying for Nations, Regions, and Communities

**Introduction:** God's intent is to bless a people and their nation. The condition for a nation to be blessed is to remain under His covenant. God is always calling nations to come to Him.

**Deut 28:16- 68.** These verses reiterate the curses God visits on His children living in rebellion. When a nation or community is steeped in sin/iniquity, the curses of God are drawn to that city- This includes a *closed heaven, famine, confusion, terrorism, strange diseases, barrenness, oppression* etc. These adverse conditions can be changed through *repentance and prayer*.

**Fasting and prayer** bring benefits to our nation. Through our obedience, we loosen the hand of wickedness upon the city/nation.

**2Ch 7:13-15** If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; *then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attent unto the prayer [that is made] in this place.*

**Day 8-Pray for the healing of our nation, city. 2 Chr. 7:12-15; Daniel 9:3-20; Neh 1**

Sickness in humans is traced to sin, so sickness in a nation is traced to sin. When a nation is in sin, curses reign, the heaven is shut and then the domino effect starts. Daniel showed us the way out; he confessed his personal sins and that of the nation- **Daniel 9:3-20.**

- Balaam could not curse Israel when they were aligned to His plans. His counsel to Balak was to entice Israel to sin and thus make them vulnerable- **Numbers 31:16.**
- Righteousness exalts a nation, But sin is a reproach to any people -**Pro 14:34**

### Confession

- We confess the sins of leaders of the nation against innocent people whose blood is crying for vengeance-**Jonah 3.** When a whole city turned to God, He restored them.
- We pray for the peace and prosperity of this nation-**Jer 29:7**-our peace is linked to the peace and prosperity of our cities/nations
- Father, let the gates of this nation be crowned with Your righteousness-**Prov 14:34**
- Father, raise watchmen for this nation/city who will not rest until Your name is exalted everywhere. Let this nation be a praise on the earth in Jesus' name- **-Isaiah 62:1-7**
- Father, let there be a mighty visitation of Your Holy Spirit in this nation
- In the name of Jesus, I declare the covering of the Lord over my life, family, and city
- Father, let there be a speedy manifestation of Your promises concerning my life and family.
- I will live and not die to declare the works of the Lord. Amen
- I break the cycles of bondage and generational curses over this nation in Jesus' name.
- I activate the blood upon the gates and walls of this city against demonic intrusions.



## **Day 9-Praying over territories** -Deal with territorial powers that control regions

Cities and regions are ruled by territorial spirits. Cities have distinct cultures that fights against the Truth. Prayer will erase that culture/weaken the hold of that culture and establish a **Jesus culture-Matt 28:19; Daniel 10:10-14**

-strongholds (predominant thought pattern in a region) that are contrary to God's word

### **Prayer/Confession**

- Thank You Father that You have forgiven us as a nation. I appropriate the mercies in the blood of Jesus to override any judgment set over this nation – **James 2:13.**
- I erase any *false standard* of the enemy with the blood of Jesus-**Zech 1:16-21**
- Let the voice of evil counselors over our nation be overturned in Jesus' name.
- I destroy the horns of the enemy that has been scattering the city/nation
- Let the head of this city be exalted with glory once again.
- We disarm any strongman assigned to keep this city in captivity in Jesus' name- **Luk 11:21**
- Let the fire of the Lord destroy any strongman that has kept the souls of men in bondage.
- We break and destroy every spiritual containment in Jesus' name. Amen
- Father, deploy Your angels to keep watch over this city. This city shall be a city without walls because of the multitude of business and men in it
- I command the ancient gates/principalities that have been ruling this city to give way so that the King of Glory will reign-**Psalm 24:7**
- I render null and void every ritual, incantation, spell and curses issued against this city in the blood of Jesus- **Rev 12:11**
- Father, command Your light to shine in pockets of this nation that has been designated as a haven of wickedness – **Psa 74:20; Mat 4:16**
- I destroy any covering of death that has been cast upon cities in the name of Jesus
- I dissolve, melt and utterly destroy structures, systems that have been raised to enforce captivity in my city in Jesus' name.
- Father, remember this city once again.
- I pray for the peace and prosperity of this city-**Jer. 29:7**
- Father, raise men and women who will preach, teach, and disciple many in this city – **Matt 28:18**

## Day 10-Pray for Leaders-1 Ti 2:1-4; Proverb 21:1

These prayers should be for our local/state/federal leaders

- Father, align the heart of our leaders to Your truth- **Proverb 21:1**
- Father, let the leaders of our community encounter Your power in Jesus' name - **Dan 4:36**
- Father, let our leaders who do not know You, encounter Your word-**1 Ti 2:1-4**
- I silence the voice of evil counsellors around them who will distract them from listening to the voice of God – **Acts 13:8**
- Father, grant them wisdom to make decisions that will bring peace and prosperity to the nation in Jesus' name.
- Father, deliver the leaders of our communities from deadly traps and assassins.
- Father, surround the leaders of the nation with Your glory and preserve them from the wicked one-**Psalm 3:2,3; 2Thess 3:1-3**
- Father, endue our leaders with the spirit of wisdom, counsel might, fear of the Lord that they govern this nation rightly-**Isaiah 11:2,3**
- I come against evil activities in my neighborhood and prophesy the peace of God in my community- **Isa 60:18**
- I uproot any evil tree planted against the leaders in my nation in Jesus' name - **Mat 15:13**
- I ask and receive divine wisdom, knowledge, and understanding to live in the fullness of God's purpose for my life.
- Father, sustain our leaders with corn, wine, and oil and cause them to walk in the overflow in Jesus' name. Amen
- Father, I ask that by the power of the Holy Spirit, the hearts of my family be turned towards You. Let them renew their confidence in Your promised provisions for their lives in Jesus' name. Amen- **Phil 4:19**

## **Day 11-13-Prayer for supernatural Church growth**

God's intention for saving us is that we are equipped to also reach others. One of the weapons needed to do this assignment is prayer. God's agenda is that His house be full and that all nations be saved.

\*Ask for the heathens/unsaved-**Psalm 2:8**-we pray that as many who are not saved be saved in Jesus' name

### **Day 11-Warfare in soul winning**

The enemy (strongman) will not let souls without a fight, so we must engage him in warfare to secure the destinies of our loved ones from the wicked one-**Eph 6:10-18**

We are fighting with wicked spirits who are comfortable and will want to maintain the status quo. When we engage him with the consciousness that we are already winners we can let them free. The only weapon that the enemy understands is vengeance, therefore apply your authority in God and take your captives away.

- Father, by the blood of Jesus, execute your judgment against powers of this land who are keeping our sons and daughters captive-**Ex 12:12**
- In the name of Jesus, I command spiritual prison doors be opened. Let souls locked up be delivered in Jesus' name.
- I bind and destroy any decision or scheme of satan against the growth or advancement of Your church
- Every hand of the devil seeking to hinder the spiritual growth of Your children is cut off in Jesus' name.
- I plead for the mercies of God to free my relatives from the consequences of their sins in Jesus' name.
- Father, unveil the eyes of understanding of sinners that they can see the glory in the gospel – **2 Cor 4:4**
- I break and destroy any argument of thought pattern that hinders them from hearing the gospel in Jesus' name.
- I break free from habits and limitations that hinders them from hearing the good news in Jesus' name.
- I cut asunder in iron chains that have bound my relatives in Jesus' name.
- I set my relatives from any cord that has tied them to iniquity in Jesus' name. Amen.
- I arrest any strongman from their family background or community that frustrate ministers of the gospel in Jesus' name.
- Father, raise angels and let them help Your ministers working in the harvest field.
- Father, release abundant resources for the work of soul winning in Jesus' name. Amen.
- Father, grant Your ministers wisdom and understanding to create effective discipleship systems.
- Father, send more laborers into the harvest field in Jesus' name. Amen – **Mat 9:36**
- Let God arise and let the enemies of the gospel scatter- **Psa 68**
- Father, silence every evil counselor trying to keep Your saints in captivity in Jesus' name
- Father in the name of Jesus, I decree Your vengeance against satanic forces resisting the continuous growth of this church **Acts 13:7-11**

## Day 12-Pray for the Works of the Holy Spirit to Facilitate Church Growth

The Holy Spirit is the Lord of the harvest-the day He was released, 3000 men were saved-**Acts 2:41-46; Acts 4:4-5000** men. After that incidence, He continued to add to church daily them that had to be saved. Any miracle witnessed in the Bible was to add souls to the church. The gospel cannot be in words only, it is good news when it can be experienced.

Jesus said “*Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves-* **Jhn 14:11.**

He was stressing the importance of the works of the Holy Spirit in preaching the gospel.

Our prayer this year is that *by the help of the Holy Spirit*, we can be effective in soul winning and that signs and wonders will be our daily story-**Acts 4:29-33**

### Confessions

- Father, fill me with Your Spirit once again. Empower me to preach the word boldly in Jesus’ name. Amen - **Acts 4:29-33**
- Father, anoint me with the Holy Spirit and with power to heal the sick and deliver the oppressed in Jesus’ name – Acts 10:38
- Holy Spirit, accompany us in our soul-winning endeavors. Confirm the word that is spoken with signs and wonders-**Mark 16:16-20**
- Let the works of the Holy Spirit be manifested in our meetings in the name of Jesus-
- Father, fill every leader with the Holy Spirit and manifest your gifts in them for effective training and raising more leaders -1 Cor 12
- Let the life of every member of this congregation be filled with Your testimonies.
- Let our testimonies be an instrument for winning and raising more souls.
- Holy Spirit, lead me to the place of God’s promised provision for my assignment – **Isa 45:1-3**
- Holy Spirit, draw people to places where the gospel will be ministered to them
- Father, fill the mouths of the youth and children with power to be Your witnesses-**Psa 8:2**
- Father, lead me to discover Your goodness and the blessings of increase which You have prepared for me this year.

## **Day -13-Pray for Salvation of Family and Relations-1 Ti 2:1-4**

When God saves one man, His intention is to save the whole family-**Acts 16:31; Acts 2:38,19**  
**Pray for family members who are ensnared by the wiles/tricks of the enemy (2 Cor. 4:3-5)**

### **Supplications and Intercession**

- I pray that Your mercy will reign in the life of my relatives who do not know You-**Rom 1:20-32**
- Father, do not count their sins against them and turn their hearts back to You
- I pray that every veil that is covering their eyes be removed in Jesus' name. Let their eyes will be opened to understand Your gospel-**2 Cor 4:4-6**
- I silence any strange voice that is hindering them from hearing Your word-**Acts 13:7-12**
- I strike any agent of the devil with blindness that they will never find them
- Let any ancient gates, ancestral powers holding them give way to Your voice in Jesus' name- **Psalm 24:7-10**
- Let every evil altar that has been raised against my relatives be roasted by fire in Jesus' name.
- Father, I remove the name of my relatives from evil covenants that hinders their salvation and deliverance in Jesus' name.
- Father, destroy the wicked one who comes to devour the harvest of blessing – **Judge 6**
- I plead the blood of Jesus over my life and declare that I am preserved against anything intended to diminish the glory of God in my life.
- I declare that my family is secured and sustained by God's continual provision.
- Father, protect family and I against every form of evil fashioned against our lives.
- Father, protect every opportunity earmarked for my breakthrough and increase this year.
- Father, let the ministry gifts (apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher) abound in our churches- **Eph 4:11-16**
- Let our churches be places where disciples are adequately prepared for effective ministry work in Jesus' name- **2Ti 2:2**.

**Day 14-** Thanksgiving for A successful week of prayer-**Phil 4:6,7**

Confidence in God moves us to give Him thanks in anticipation of answers to our prayers. Thanksgiving sets our hearts at rest and receive His finished works or directions concerning what He wants us to do. Spend the day and give thanks to God and present your personal supplications to the Lord according to His will-1 **John 5:14, 15; Jer 33:3; Luk 11:9-13**

**Psa 40:5** O LORD my God, you have performed many wonders for us. Your plans for us are too numerous to list. You have no equal. If I tried to recite all your wonderful deeds, I would never come to the end of them.

- Father, thank You for the awesome testimonies You have given us for the past weeks.
- I thank You for another week to keep on pressing into Your presence
- I ask for grace to continually yield to the Holy Spirit and His promptings and guidance in the coming week – **Rom 8:14**
- Father, order my steps in the right track and make my path to be straight.
- Father, flood my heart with Your light to walk in Your revealed purpose for my life – **Eph 1:17-21**
- I know You are able to give beyond what I have asked or have been thinking in Jesus' name. be afraid to ask big for our God has it all.

## **Week 3- Day 15-17- Breaking curses releasing blessings- Isaiah 58:6-14**

### **Day 15 – Dealing with the Root of Curses**

- What is a curse? It is the opposite of blessings. It is to speak or wish evil against a person or thing. It is an invisible barrier that hinders people from accessing what God has for them.
- A curse placed on you will not work without legal or spiritual grounds – **Pro 26:2; Num 23:8; Gen 8:22.**
- Curses results from protracted living in disobedience to God’s word -**Deu 28:16-68.**
- When a curse is in operation, it manifests in protracted barrenness, sickness, cycle of failure, stagnation, strange negative occurrences, frustrations, marital strife, wayward children.
- When people choose a lifestyle of sin, they attract a curse.
- Curses can be invoked when we violate the principle of honor and integrity in our relationships (knowingly or unknowingly)- **Ecc 10:8**
- Anything you do for a long time becomes a habit, which turns into a character that finally determines the environment you create around you.
- Fasting breaks the ties of wickedness, false language, evil intentions and softens us to receive God’s word (repentance).
- Christ has redeemed us from the curse of law, because He became a curse for us – **Gal 3:13,14**
- The blood of Jesus redeems us, washes away the seed of iniquity and reminds us of what has been done for you.
- God has given you the authority to cast down, bind, throw down, destroy everything that is not from Him-**Jer 1:5,10; Matt 16:18,19.**

In the next three days let this be your focus. Just as you prayed earlier on, success in our new life is recognizing what He has done for us.

### **Confessions to break curses**

- I confess and forsake any besetting sins in the name of Jesus
- I set myself free from the bondage of sin in the name of Jesus
- In the name of Jesus of I set myself free from every bond of wickedness in my life
- I let go of any heavy burden of unforgiveness, rejection, abuse, anger, bitterness, disappointments, hurts etc in the blood of Jesus.
- Father, send Your healing power into the foundation of my life – **2 Ki 2:13-21**
- I have been translated from darkness (curses) into light (blessings) – **Col 1:12,13**
- I command all curses issued against my life to be broken in Jesus’ name.
- I close any door that I have opened to life under a curse by my actions/inactions in Jesus’ name
- I plead the blood of Jesus to erase any trace of shame or reproach in my life
- I set myself free from anything that ties me down to a past negative lifestyle be it spiritual, emotional, or physical.

- I take authority over curses emanating from *careless words, spiritual ignorance, dishonoring authorities, evil dedication, witchcraft curses, cursed associations, satanic agents*, and command them to be broken in Jesus' name.
- By the mercies in the blood of Jesus, I neutralize any curse that has resulted from my sins, disobedience, utterances, or careless living - **2Pe 2:14**.
- Father, strengthen me to stand in every moment of distress and loss. Cause that all things to work together for my good – **Rom 8:28**.
- Father. I ask for the commitment to abide in Your presence. Teach me to hear Your voice clearly in Jesus' name.
- I declare that I will hear and obey every word that He speaks as I wait on Him
- I thank You Father for You promise to direct my path as I trust You with all my ways – **Pro 3:5**.
- I will not suffer any loss as I walk according to the leading of Your Spirit.



## Day 16

Introduction: One of the benefits of fasting is the opportunity for soul searching that can lead to revelation, conviction, repentance, and warfare – **Psa 139:23**.

- God's word is a sure word of prophecy. Praying the word is praying His will into being – **1 John 5:14**.

**Isaiah 58:3-12** will be our anchor scripture for confessing the blessing in fasting today.

### Confessions

- I repent from any strife, quarreling, fighting that I have been involved in Jesus' name.
- I declare myself free from any yoke of oppression in the name of Jesus.
- I release the fire of God to destroy any root of wickedness in me in Jesus' name.
- I remove myself from the spirit of accusations, criticism, and backbiting in Jesus' name.
- Let all curses spoken over my life be turned into blessing in Jesus' name.
- Let every power maintaining curses over my life be broken in Jesus' name.
- Let every chain or cord that has tied me and resisting my movement be broken in Jesus' name- **1Jo 3:8**
- I liberate myself from thoughts and reasonings that lead me to make wrong decisions and stay in a negative cycle- **Rom 12**.
- I command any curse spoken over my life that restricts me to be broken in Jesus' name
- As Jesus sent the disciples to untie the colt, I have received mandate to untie destinies.
- I live the abundant life as Jesus ordained – **John 10:10; 2 Cor 8:9**.
- I receive grace to be a blessing to as many that the Lord brings to my path.
- I receive God's light (knowledge, wisdom, revelation, understanding) in my life. I have access to God's mind concerning my life and family.
- I walk in light, and I know what needs to be done through visions, dreams, prophecies and revealed word
- The light of God in me is springing up in the midst of darkness.
- The Lord will guide me continually with His eyes. My ears, eyes, and heart are attentive to His instructions. I will not miss my divine guidance in Jesus' name.
- I reverse every curse of infirmity or affliction, and I receive the healing in my life (spirit, soul & body) in Jesus' name.
- I am surrounded by God's glory-He has placed a demarcation between me and my enemies.
- I am the righteousness of God in Christ.
- I receive quick answers to my prayers for I am praying according to His will
- The Lord will satisfy every hunger in my spirit, soul, and body. He will refresh my thirsty soul
- The Lord will strengthen my bones.
- Every dry area of my life is receiving the rain from heaven in Jesus' name. I will no longer dwell in the dry places

## Day 17

Introduction: Both blessings and curses are invoked through spirit-inspired words. Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, speak these prophetic promises into your life.

“I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;- **Deu 30:19**

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. – **Pro 18:21**

### Confessing the Blessing

- In the name of Jesus, I will spring forth and blossom like a well-watered garden.
- The Lord has made me a spring of water that I can water those who are dry.
- I have received the anointing to rebuild every ruin or destruction in my life, family, ministry, and city in Jesus' name
- I destroy every evil foundation in my life, and I raise up a new godly foundation that will bless many generations.
- Like my father Abraham, many shall call me a restorer and a builder of homes and a source of blessing to nations
- The Lord will cause me to ride on the high places on the earth. He has lifted me from obscurity to prominence
- The Lord will exalt my horn like that of a buffalo
- Father, send me my destiny helpers quickly-**Psalm 20; Psalm 121**
- Father, unveil my eyes to walk in the revelation of Your purpose for my life-**Eph 1;16-21**
- Father, thank You all the Christian leaders You are raising to build and establish the church
- Father, release divine strength and power into the body of Christ for the work of soul-winning and discipleship - **Acts 1:8**.
- Let Your mercy triumph over every demand of justice for my wrong doings- **Jas 2:13**.
- Anywhere my careless life has opened the door for a curse to remain, I repent quickly, and I ask that the mercy of God will overturn every judgment of the wicked against me.
- Where my actions opened doors for the enemy to gain access to my soul, I ask for mercy.
- Let the blood purge me and bring back my soul from captivity.
- I disconnect my soul from realms of darkness
- I destroy any seed of the enemy in my life
- I destroy any structure or thought pattern designed to trap me in Jesus' name – **1 Jo 3:8; 2 Cor 10:3-5**.

## Day 18-Release of the Power of God - Joel 2:18-25

Introduction: Fasting gives occasion for God's children to lay aside the weights/sins of the past; things that disconnect us from the Vine. We then take conscious steps to reconnect to the Fountain of Living Water-**Jer 2:13**.

This is referred to as **RESTORATION**. The Holy Spirit (Rain, Water, Fire) is the principal agent in restoration.

- Then the LORD will be jealous for his land and take pity on his people.

Vrs. 19 "I am sending you *grain, new wine and oil*, enough to satisfy you fully; never again will I make you an object of scorn to the nations.

### Declarations

- I rejoice because the Lord has done great and marvelous things in Jesus' name.
- The Lord has turned my captivity around. The fig and the vine will yield their strength by the help of God.
- Every reproach in and around me had been removed by the blood of Jesus.
- Let there be a release of fresh Oil- anointing, power, mandate from God to do good-**Acts 10:38; Luke 4:18**
- I abolish destitution- the season of lack and not enough for self and family are over
- In the name of Jesus, I drive out the northern army (wicked spirits, habits, sins, iniquities, demonic oppression, depression etc) into dry places- **Hosea 9:14; Jel 2:20**
- By the reason of the anointing, I shall see my desires on my enemies in Jesus' name – **Psa 92:10**.
- I declare a restoration of ALL my wasted years and resources.
- Let all my stolen virtues be returned in Jesus' name.
- Every locust assigned to devour my harvest will die by fire in Jesus' name.
- The time of my celebration has come - for Lord is bringing rain and harvest –**Joel 2:21**
- My levels have increased – **Joel 2: 24**- I have moved from lack to just enough; from just enough to overflowing- grain, wine, and oil- **Matt 2:10** exceeding great joy
- I have obtained power to be a living witness- **Acts 1:8**
- The Lord has restored all that was stolen from me and compensated me for my loss
- *God will give you a cause to celebrate and forever wipe away every shame- Is 25:6-12*  
**Job 42:5; Joel 2:26**

### Day -19– Outpour of the Holy Spirit Joel 2:26-29

God rewards those who wait on Him with a release of His Spirit on them. the desire for an outpouring of the Spirit is to cause our dry places to receive rain again - **Isa 32:15**.

**Joel 2:28** "And afterward, *I will pour out my Spirit on all people*. Your sons and daughters will *prophesy*, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. **Joe 2:29** Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days.

When the Spirit is poured on you your words change- change your confessions and declarations-

- Lord, give me a fresh vision for my life in Jesus' name-
- Father, I declare in **2025**, I shall eat in plenty, and my soul will be satisfied in Jesus' name.
- May the anointing that changes lives, turn me into a godly vessel in Jesus' name-**1 Sam 10:6**
- May the Holy Spirit launch me into my calling in Jesus' name-**Acts 13:1 Job 22:23-30**
- Father, as I have returned to You, build me and my family up in Jesus' name.
- The Lord is building you up; He is building your family up again
- Father, let good health and prosperity overflow in my life in Jesus' name.
- Father, preserve me and my household in Jesus' name.
- I exempt myself and my family from diseases, pestilences, and misfortunes, that others are professing in Jesus' name.
- Please set us apart and hide us under the Shadow of the Almighty.
- I cancel and break every cycle of failure at the edge of success in Jesus' name.
- I have Intimate communication with God
- Because I have set the Lord ALWAYS before me, I cannot be moved in Jesus' name-**Psa 16**
- I have received divine ability to create and sustain wealth -**Deu 8:18**

## Day 20-celebration of victory

Neh 8:9 And Nehemiah, which [is] the Tirshatha, and Ezra the priest the scribe, and the Levites that taught the people, said unto all the people, This day [is] holy unto the LORD your God; mourn not, nor weep. For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the law. Neh 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for [this] day [is] holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; **for the joy of the LORD is your strength.**

**I waited patiently for the LORD; And He inclined to me, And heard my cry. He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, Out of the miry clay, And set my feet upon a rock, [And] established my steps.** He has put a new song in my mouth--Praise to our God; Many will see [it] and fear, And will trust in the LORD. Blessed [is] that man who makes the LORD his trust, And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies. Many, O LORD my God, [are] Your wonderful works Which You have done; And Your thoughts toward us Cannot be recounted to You in order; [If] I would declare and speak [of them], They are more than can be numbered. **Psa 40:1-5**

*What happened in the past weeks is that you took time off to wait on the Lord and He has heard you and delivered you out of that horrible pit. The pit can be any condition in your life or family that was less than what God purposed for you. Because He has heard you, you must celebrate Him. Your song must change from pain/sorrow to celebration. Rise up get food, gather the family, and rejoice for your God has established/enlarged your steps. There is no way for us to count/number the things that He's done for us.*

Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable. **He gives power to the weak,** And to [those who have] no might He increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, **But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew [their] strength;** They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint. **Isa 40:28-31**

*One of the benefits of fasting is that the Lord pours His strength on us for us to go strongly and do things that we feared in the past. As you wrap up this session, walk in the awareness that you have been endued with supernatural strength from God to go through the divine assignments that He has for you throughout the year. Your strength has been renewed and now you will soar over problems instead of being stuck like before.*

- Thank the Lord for His abiding presence that leads you in His truth and righteousness.
- Silence the voice of the deceiver that seeks to lure you away from the paths of righteousness.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to instruct you in the ways of the Lord daily
- Pray for the spirit of the fear of the Lord, revelation, counsel, might, wisdom and understanding on you and your family. You will not repeat the mistakes of the past.
- Call on the Holy Spirit to guide you to use your resources to glorify God.

## Day 21 - Living in God's Realm of Knowledge

- Fasting unveils mysteries and **aligns us to God's perfect will for us-Rom 12:1,2**. These times that you have connected to God, you want to walk consciously of the things that have been deposited in you via communing with God.
- Any time a place or people adjust fit the design of God; the end is glory. When they built according to pattern it was glory. "And he reared up the court round about the tabernacle and the altar, and set up the hanging of the court gate. So, ***Moses finished the work***. Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and ***the glory of the LORD filled*** the tabernacle. Exo 40:33,34". I pray that the glory of the Lord rests on you.
- I pray that you will walk through this year fulfilling your divine agenda. I pray that you will be filled with all supernatural wisdom to know what to be done at every point in time of your life. **Eph 1:16-22**
  
- Live a ***life of joy*** for that is your strength
- Live a life that ***honors God***, for you have become one with God
- Live a ***life that succeeds*** because the DNA of success has been impacted to you at birth
- Live in your ***spiritual intelligence*** so that you are always ahead
- Live in your new levels of ***spiritual abundance, excellence, prosperity*** in Jesus' name.
- May ***light beam your path*** so that you will live this year as God has ordained in heaven
- Live in ***all your heavenly possibilities*** -NO LIMITS.
- Live a ***purpose-driven life*** full of anointing and power
- Live a ***Spirit-led life***.

## **Cultivating a daily Devotional Life- Quiet Time**

Quiet time or daily devotion is a spiritual exercise or discipline that ensures the believer has a steady balanced diet of *Word, Prayer and Worship*. It is a system instituted to build intimacy with the Father. The Founder of our faith, Jesus Christ is described several times in the bible as retreating Himself to a quiet place to pray and commune with the Father. Such communications allowed Him to live as a Son of God on this earth. If we are going to do the same, then we need to cultivate this discipline. It is usually called a quiet time, because it is a time to zone out from daily distractions and zone in to commune with the Father to draw strength and guidance for the day. If you are about to begin this journey, remember that to build a discipline, it takes sacrifice and conscientious planning and dedication. I pray that God grants you every grace you need to make it happen.

**What time** – Anytime is acceptable but I will recommend first thing in the morning (for someone with a day job) so that you can engage His strength throughout the day –**Mark 1:35**. “while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a *solitary place*, where he prayed. If Jesus needed to be alone in prayer so do we. Let’s get on this journey.

**How much time should I use?** It depends. Be flexible because this is a time with your Father. You don’t want it to be a drag too. I will recommend 10-15 minutes for starters. As you enjoy this time, you can then easily extend it.

**What to bring?** Bible, journal, pen, devotional guide (or use various plans from bible app); you can select a book in the bible.

**Activities to engage in-** Thanksgiving, Praise, Prayer, reading Word, meditation, journaling.

## **Suggested steps to effective Daily Devotion**

1. Begin with Prayer of **adoration**. Who is God to you? So you can begin to say Father, I honor You this morning for who You are. You have been a shield around me and the One who lifted me out of trouble (this is just a suggestion. The psalms gives you ideas on how to adore God.
2. Is there any sin to **confess** and repent? Anytime we spend with God, is an opportunity to allow Him to purge us from all forms of unrighteousness. The Blood of Jesus has paid the price of our sins so don’t feel condemned.

3. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you through this moment of intimacy, to open your eyes to truth in the Word and to speak to you.
4. **Read the Bible** assigned for the day according to your bible plan or devotional guide prayerfully (If you are using a devotional guide that should be the last thing to read). Apply the steps to effective bible reading below. Pray along while reading in case you sense the need to. Think through what you are reading (meditate); allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you
5. **Journal any directions the Holy Spirit gives you as you read. Pray using the scripture studied as unveiled by the Holy Spirit**
6. **Thank God for such as awesome time in His Presence**
7. **Pray for your needs and that of others**-I recommend you keep a "prayer book"--a little book listing requests and answers, including notations regarding when you began to pray for something and when it was answered. This will encourage you to keep at it. Put in your family, friends, yes, your enemies (if any), those in authority in church and state, and pressing needs--finances, health, and the salvation of others. Have a mix of your own needs and intercessions for others. You may find your prayers for others get answered before your own needs!



## **A Template for an Effective Bible reading**

The threefold process of observation, interpretation, and application is effective during a quiet time.

**Observation-** read the bible and observe what the passage is saying and describing.

First, read through a portion of Scripture and then go back and make some initial observations about it: **Who are the characters?** **What's** going on? **Where** is this taking place? **WHEN** do/will the events occur or did/will something happen to someone? **WHY** is something being said or mentioned? **HOW** will it happen?

**Interpretation** -Interpretation refers to understanding the overall meaning. It is discerning the primary meaning of the passage – what the biblical author was seeking to communicate and what God was seeking to communicate through that biblical author. “What prompted the author to write this passage?” Keeping these questions in mind can help you uncover the primary meaning of the text.

**Application:** This entails how the passage you read applies to you and others. And what are some actions you need to take to apply God’s Word directly to your life? This is a good point for reflection and meditation and allowing the Holy Spirit to unveil what to take home.

God, what are you trying to say to me through this passage?

In what ways do we need to be more intimate in our relationship?

What promises are there in this that I need to appropriate?

What examples do I have to follow? What adjustments in character/attitude do I need?

## **A TEMPLATE FOR PRAYER**

A time spent reading the word creates a desire to talk with God. Revelation of God's power in the bible stirs up faith to believe God for your own victory. By spending time in God's Word, we open ourselves up to his voice and he can speak to us directly – something he often does.

Prayer is a natural response to God's work in our life. It is a two-way communication between God and man. Just as the art of effective communication is learned, prayer can be learned. The ACTS model: adoration, confession, thanksgiving, and supplication is one model that you can employ in your devotion. As you grow, you can modify it to suit you.

**Adoration:** Telling God how great he is, why he's great (merciful, kind, and so on), and how much we love him for it.

**Confession:** Acknowledging to God any known sin that is displeasing to him so that we can come to him unhindered, completely surrendered and cleansed.

**Thanksgiving:** Thanking God for his grace and forgiveness in our lives, and thanking him for all the things He's done for us and given to us.

**Supplication:** Asking God for things that we want.

## **A TEMPLATE FOR QUIET TIMES**

Adoration: "Lord, I praise you for ... (some quality of attribute of God)."

Confession: "Lord, forgive me for ... (for some sin or shortcoming)."

Listen to God

Prayerfully read a passage. What does it say?

Prayerfully reflect on its meaning. What does it mean?

Prayerfully apply it to life. What does it mean for me?

Talk to God

Thanksgiving: "Lord, I thank you for ... (some specific blessing)."

Supplication: "Lord, I ask you for ... (requests for yourself and others)."

Talk to God, listen to God, and then talk to God again. It's that easy.
